VOTER REGISTRATION

To vote you must register. You must register again when you move or change your name.

Any US citizen who was born on or before November 8, 1998 may register to vote. *Since 2014, 17 year olds may register and VOTE in the Primary Election if they will be 18 by the General Election.* The deadline for registering outside of the election offices is February 16, 2016.

WHAT YOU NEED REGISTER TO VOTE

- Two forms of identification, one must show your current address, and current name. The other just your current name.
- The last four numbers of your Social Security.
- If you are a naturalized citizen, the date and place (City & Court) of your naturalization

ONLINE REGISTRATION

To register online you must have a current Illinois driver's license or Illinois State ID. The online voter registration application website is ova.elections.il.gov.

VOTE BY MAIL

You may request an application for a ballot 90 days before the election (December 16, 2015). You may request an application for a ballot online at your election office website. Ballots will be mailed to you beginning 40 days before the election (Feb. 4, 2016). The last day a ballot will be mailed to you is 5 days before the election (March 10, 2016). Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Election Day (March 15, 2016).

GRACE PERIOD REGISTRATION AND VOTING

Grace period voting is an extension of the deadline for registration. You must have lived at your current address 30 days prior to the election. Keep in mind you must register and vote at the same time, so be prepared to vote.

Grace period registration and voting in Election Offices begins February 17, 2016 to March 14, 2016.

ELECTION DAY SAME DAY REGISTRATION

For the 2016 Election, registration and voting will be available at polling places.

EARLY VOTING

Early voting in the election offices starts February 4 to March 14, 2016. In addition to the Election Office, the City of Rockford will have an offsite location for Early Voting at Emmanuel Episcopal Church 412 N. Church Street. (Use the entrance on Park Avenue.)

If you would like to avoid long lines at the polls or possible inclement weather on Election Day, we *encourage* you to take advantage of Early Voting or Vote by Mail alternatives.
